Matt will be receiving Chemo every Thursday now, along with his Radiation. He only has two more Radiation treatments, to the spine area and rest of the brain. He will then have (21) more treatments, to the tumor area of the brain only.

Matt coached first base the first game and just watched the second game. Matt batted in the last inning, of the first game and he walked. He then stole second and third. He was feeling great during the games, but was really tired that night.

If Matt feels up to it, he will be going to a basketball clinic put on by the Golden State Warriors, tomorrow afternoon with his Dad. This event is for children going through treatment and Matt was chosen by his Oncology team at Stanford to attend.

Matt added four fish to his team and named them Goldie, Chemo, Spots and AC/DC. We lost AC/DC, we think due to the water change. His new teammates seem to be getting along well with Beans, Rice and Coco.

Irene and Matt will be heading back to Fremont, tonight or Monday morning, for Matt's treatments this upcoming week.
